## **EPILEPSY AWARENESS**

## **Overview**

The course will discuss the basic care and management of a patient/client with epilepsy within the health care sector. It will enhance awareness and provide the learners with the fundamental information they require within their area of work. The course is suitable for any personnel working in the health care sector that have not received any previous epilepsy awareness training.

Participants will be able to:

- Define Epilepsy & the effects.
- Identify the basic treatment of epilepsy.
- Discuss the basic fundamental management of an epileptic seizure.
- Identify safety measures at the care home.
- Have an understanding of the holistic needs of a patient/client with epilepsy.
- Discuss how you can be prepared, and support the necessary needs of the individual within the care environment.
- Updating Care Plans to suit individuals need.

Staff will gain a stronger confidence whilst working with individuals with Epilepsy, they will understand possible triggers and response methods necessary to support an individual. Discussing the importance of documentation. And methods of improvement where necessary.
